Sacramento has the third highest union density of any city in the United States. Our union population is extremely engaged in promoting a community that supports working families. Our strength is our diversity. While there are many terrific union publications out there, most are specific to one industry or segment of the union population. The Bulletin spans the broadest possible spectrum of unions - we reach teachers, nurses, construction workers, postal workers, public sector employees, stage hands, laborers and many, many more.

The nonprofit newspaper was the first labor-owned and labor-controlled newspaper in the history of Sacramento. It first published on Sept. 3, 1928 – Labor Day – and remains the only official AFL-CIO newspaper in the Sacramento area.

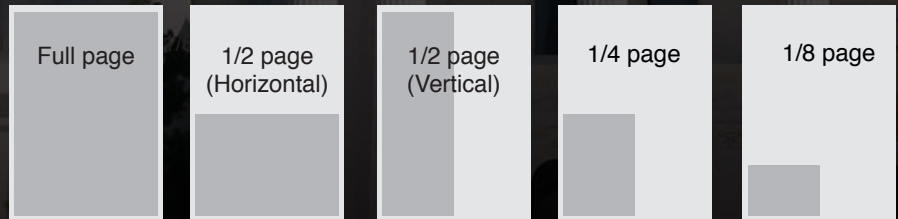
